• Grading and Weighted Grades

- 1. Second grade vanguard spelling test grading policy: 10 words randomly selected from the list of 20 spelling words; dictation sentences with spelling words in sentences 5 points off for punctuation and capitalization errors, 5 points off for misspelled spelling words, 2 points off for all other misspelled words
- 2. Reading: 70% reading tests and 30% spelling, grammar, DOL
- 3. Math: 70% math tests and 30% class work and Mad Minute

Homework

- 1. Read, read! Charlie Brown Reading Log Read a minimum of 60 minutes a week aloud to an adult. Reading logs go home on Wednesdays and are returned the following Wednesday.
- 2. Practice and memorize Math Facts to 18 (i.e. 8+6, 14-6)
- 3. Homework will go home on Monday. The packet will include reading comprehension. Please check your child's work. They should prove their answers by underlining their proof.
- 4. Homework should be turned in by the child on Friday morning.
- 5. Study for spelling test and sentence dictation (given on Fridays).
- 6. Special projects will be assigned throughout the year.

• Morning Drop-Off

- 1. Students must wait outside or in the cafeteria before the bell rings.
- 2. Students may **NOT** go to their lockers before the bell rings.
