

GRADUATION 2022 FAQ

Congratulations to our Class of 2022 graduates. Westside's graduation ceremony will be held at NRG Stadium on Sunday, June 12th at 1:00 PM. Here is a compiled list of frequently asked questions pertaining to the graduation ceremony.

1. Will there be tickets for Westside's graduation?

- Since graduation is at NRG stadium, there is no ticket system for our ceremony.

2. Is the stadium equipped for disabled guests?

- Yes. Disabled parking is first come first serve and the stadium is equipped to host attendees who are in a wheelchair.



3. How much does it cost to park at NRG stadium?

- It is \$20 per car to park at NRG Stadium. **CASH ONLY**

4. What is proper attire for graduates?

- Graduates should dress nicely (**i.e., Sunday's best or business casual**) for the graduation ceremony. Jean and/or tennis shoes should not be worn by graduates at the ceremony.

5. When should graduates arrive to NRG?

- Graduates should arrive to NRG Stadium at 11:00 AM on June 12th. Graduates will not be permitted to enter after 11:30 AM.

6. What time can family and friends enter NRG to attend the graduation ceremony?

- Family and friends **cannot** enter NRG until the prior graduation is done and they have cleaned the graduation space.

7. What type of regalia is allowed/not allowed during the graduation ceremony?

- **ONLY** Westside issued regalia will be permitted for graduates to wear during the graduation ceremony.

8. Can graduates decorate the top of their cap?

- Yes. Your cap design must be approved, and it must be school appropriate. Specific instructions for the approval process will be given when cap and gowns are issued on June 2nd and 3rd.
