


## Early College Magnet Program

### College and Career Readiness

#### College Access

- Two college access coordinators (CACs) assigned to HAIS
- CACs help HAISters register for admissions exams like the SAT and ACT
- CACs help HAISters apply for college, scholarships, and financial aid

#### **AVID**

- Advancement via Individual Determination (AVID) is a college readiness program designed to help students develop the skills they need to be successful in college
- AVID places special emphasis on growing writing, critical thinking, teamwork, organization, and reading skills as well as providing social and emotional support to students
- AVID serves as our advocacy class, and HAISters meet in AVID every day all four years at HAIS

#### **Senior Internships**

- During junior year, our internship coordinator works with HAISters to identify potential organizations that match their career interests
- Students initiate contact with these organizations in search for an internship placement and mentor
- During senior year, students are off-campus at their internship sites
- Previous internships include placements in the medical center, in the mayor's office, at law firms, at the Houston Chronicle, in the Houston Public Library system, and many more!





### Virtual Meetings


- Magnet Thursdays (1:00 PM 1:30 PM)

- Students qualify with a **Matrix score** of **65** or higher.
- HISD Magnet Applications are now open on the <u>HISD School Choice</u> website and due by November 11 to be considered for our lottery.
- Lottery notifications will be sent to parents/guardians on January 27, 2022.


