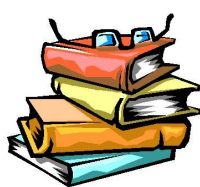


Monday, May 7, 2018

⇒ **English III (Morton):** Students are continuing to read *A Lesson Before Dying* and completing their research project focused upon ethics in science. They will begin presenting next week.

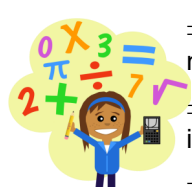
⇒ **English IV (Morton):** Students are continuing to read *Frankenstein* and completing their research project focused upon ethics in science. They will begin presenting next week.

⇒ **Geometry:** Students will prove theorems about angles inscribed in circles.

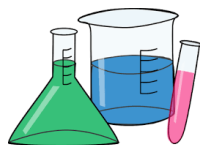
⇒ **Pre-Calculus (Kim):** Students will find the limit of the polynomials.
