English



⇒ **Pre-AP English I:** Students will prepare/review for the final exam. The final exam is comprised of an essay and multiple choice questions. Students will write the essay portion of their final exam.

⇒ **Pre-AP English II:** Students will be examining disability poetry and writing their final exam essay.

- ⇒ **English III (Morton):** Students are reading *Grapes of Wrath* by John Steinbeck to support learning about the Great Depression and New Deal era.
- ⇒ **AP/Dual Credit Language and Composition:** Students will take their English 1301 Fall Final Exam on Tuesday, December 12th, in room 203. This will count for both HCC and HAIS credit. Students will spend Thursday, December 14th, practicing for the AP exam. The review packet is due on testing day for extra credit on the exam.
- ⇒ **AP/Dual Credit British Literature:** Students will review on Monday for their Fall Final Exam. Students will take their English 2322 Fall Final Exam on Wednesday, December 13th, for both HCC and HAIS Credit. The review packet is due on testing day for extra credit on the exam.
- ⇒ **Business English:** Students will prepare for their Semester Final Exam by working on their review packets (available on the HUB). Students will review MLA Format and citation, SAT Vocabulary, literary and rhetorical analysis terms, SAT Critical Reading and Writing and Language skills, and rhetorical analysis essays. The review packet is due on testing day for extra credit on the exam.

Math



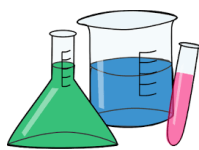
⇒ **Algebra I:** Students will review the semester's material and prepare for the final exam.

⇒ **Algebra II (Polley):** Students will review Units 1-3, functions, absolute value, and systems of linear equations, in preparation for the final exam.

⇒ **Algebra II (Baker):** Students will review the semester's material and prepare for the final exam.

- ⇒ **Geometry (Polley):** Students will review Units 1-3, tools of geometry, reasoning and proof, and parallel and perpendicular Lines in preparation for the final exam.
- ⇒ **Pre-Calculus (Kim):** Students will review for final exam.
- ⇒ **Pre-Calculus (Baker):** Students will review the semester's material and prepare for the final exam.
- ⇒ **AP Calculus:** Students will review for final exam.
- ⇒ **AP Statistics:** Students will review Unit 3, Gathering Data, and Unit 1 Exploring Data, in preparation for the final exam.
- ⇒ **College Algebra:** Students will take their final exam.

Science



⇒ **Pre-AP Biology:** Students will be working on their semester review which will cover biomolecules/enzymes, cell structure and function, DNA replication, and genetics. Upon completion, students will play an interactive review game to earn extra credit towards the final.

- ⇒ **Pre-AP Chemistry:** Students will study one last concept of calculating the limiting reagents and percent yields before working on the review pack for semester finals.
- ⇒ **AP Biology:** Students will continue to review for final exam on Tuesday, and they will take the HCC departmental final exam for 1308 on Thursday.
- ⇒ **AP Physics:** Students will review for the final exam.

Social Studies



⇒ **AP Human Geography:** Students will ace their Unit III Exams!

⇒ **US History (Morton):** Students are completing study of the Great Depression and New Deal Era and then moving into the causes and effects of World War II.
