

## At Hartman Middle School We dress like Champions!

All students attending Hartman Middle School will be required to wear the Hartman School Uniform as defined in the following policy. All articles of the uniform are to be maintained and worn in a way that represents the individual student and the school in a positive way. All articles of the uniform are to fit properly without cuts, rips or tears at hems or seams.

- □ **TOPS:** Shirts are available for purchase <u>only</u> at Hartman Middle School. Hartman polo shirts and t-shirts are required by assigned grade level colors and must have the Hartman Middle School logo. Hartman spirit shirts can be worn on Fridays with appropriate bottoms.
  - 6th grade maroon
  - 7th grade red
  - 8th grade navy blue

Uniform shirts must always be tucked in. Students who fail to comply will be in dress code violation and subject to designated consequences.

- □ **SWEATSHIRTS:** Only **plain** jackets or sweatshirts with zippers and no logo are permissible. Students should be able to unzip the jacket to display a Hartman shirt at any time.
- □ **BOTTOMS:** All students are to wear blue, black or beige jeans as well as khaki pants (Dickies classic fit/ flat front style). Pants should fit appropriately and sit on the waistline. Belts should be worn so pants don't fall below the waist.
  - No joggers
  - No capri pants or pants rolled up at bottom
  - No jeggings, spandex or tights
  - No cargo pants; No cargo shorts
  - No shorts, skirts or skorts
  - No skinny ieans
  - No rips in jeans or faded jeans













	<b>UNDERSHIRTS:</b> Students are permitted to wear white undershirts only. The white undershirts must be plain, but may be long- or short-sleeved. No graphics or lettering can be visible. Students may wear the P.E. t-shirt under their uniform shirts. Students are not to wear any shirt or t-shirt (including P.E. uniform shirts) slung over the shoulder or covering the Hartman uniform shirt.
	<ul> <li>HEAD COVERINGS: Hats, do rags, scarves, hairnets, bandanas and other headgear that is deemed to be a distraction to the learning environment are NOT permitted.</li> <li>Hairbands may be worn in the building if their purpose is to hold the hair in place and they do not distract from instruction.</li> </ul>
	<b>SHOES:</b> Shoes must allow for SAFE movement throughout the building, including the stairs.
	<ul> <li>No open-toe shoes allowed.</li> <li>Shoelaces must be tied and all straps must be strapped.</li> <li>High-heeled shoes, flip flops, house shoes/slippers, platform shoes and backless shoes are not allowed</li> </ul>
	BACKPACKS: Only clear or mesh backpacks are allowed.
	<ul> <li>distraction that it interferes with the educational process.</li> <li>Consequently, excessive makeup, body piercing (other than appropriate earrings) and hair color other than a natural shade, are not permitted.</li> <li>Excessive bracelets and bracelets with metal spikes are not permitted. Heavy chains and dog collars are not permitted.</li> <li>Tattoos must not be visible.</li> <li>Accessories of gang relation is not allowed.</li> </ul>
