Attendance

Pre-K and Kinder Age Requirements

- Pre-Kinder: Child must be 4 years of age on or before Sept. 1, 2019 (Bilingual Spanish Speakers only for Poe Elementary) must qualify for the program, child must be resident of HISD
- Kindergarten: Child must be 5 years of age on or before Sept. 1, 2019 and must reside in POE zone.

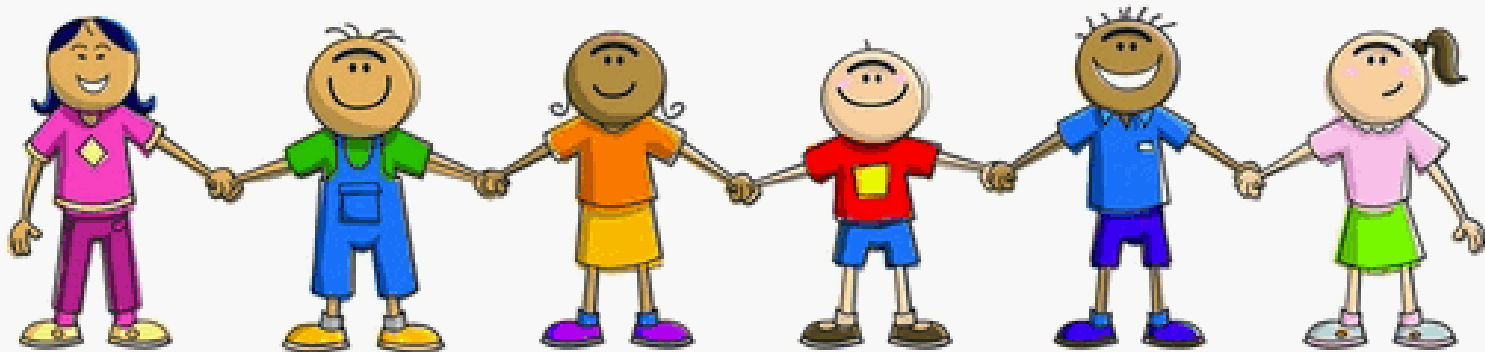
