MATH STUDENTS WILL:

In November, students will learn how to divide three and four digit dividends by two digit divisors resulting in two and three digit quotients reasoning about the decomposition of successive remainders in each place value. Students will also be dividing decimal dividends by two digit divisors, estimating quotients, reasoning about the placement of the decimal point, and making connections to a written method.

READING STUDENTS WILL:

ELA- For the month of November students will be learning about poetry while continuing to review author's purpose, theme, imagery, figurative language, plot and point of view. We will continue to practice using text evidence to support answers for multiple choice questions and constructed responses.

SCIENCE STUDENTS :

Students will continue to study properties of matter and energy. Students must be able to classify matter based on density, conductivity, solubility, and mass. We will learn about mixtures and the ways to separate based on physical property. There will be an assigned project for this month, an energy robot. I will send home information about it later this month.
