- I. Mrs. Jones opened the meeting, thanked those in attendance and made introductions.
- II. Purpose of SDMC
 - a. Responsibilities – to get feedback from the community.
- III. Campus Projection – 879
 - a. Funding for the school is made through attendance. Our Snapshot date is 10/25/2024, this coming Friday.
 - b. We are a PUA which stands for “Per Unit Allotment”
 - c. Students must be present on Snapshot Day for them to count in our allotment numbers.
 - d. Discussion ensued on various ways to encourage attendance for Friday and attendance overall.

 - b. Parents and visitors will need to buzz into this breezeway before they buss into the building. This will greatly increase the security at the front of the building.

- b. We have a nurse! She is out ½ day on Tuesdays for training right now. She is out all day every Wednesday. Health Services is going to help fill in those gaps.
