High School for Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice

Summary

The High School for Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice began in 1978 on three different campuses as a cooperative effort between HISD, the Mayor's Office and the Houston Police Department. In 1980, the current school opened at its existing location with a special effort to recruit minorities into HPD.

The school's Project Advisory Team has been working with its architects and HISD facility planners to design a new 21st century learning facility to serve generations of students to come, while building on the school's history and traditions.

✓ 104,866-square-foot, 3-story building

✓ Located off of Scott Street between Coyle and Pease Street near Interstate 45, across from the new Houston Metro rail station running along Scott

✓ In close proximity to the Houston Police Department's South Central station, the University of Houston and Texas Southern University

- ✓ Atrium space with glasss
- \checkmark Administrative area with a secure visitor check-in

✓ More than 15 learning centers and specialized learning areas for crime scene investigations, fire technology, legal studies and emergency communications

✓ Ground level will include dining space with outdoor eating areas and an athletic and ROTC facility with a canopy

- Monumental staircase will lead to second floor that houses academic neighborhoods for criminal justice and legal studies
 Third level will offer views of downtown Houston from learning areas
- ✓ Teacher work centers will encourage staff collaboration

✓ Extended learning commons for students to work and study independently or in groups
