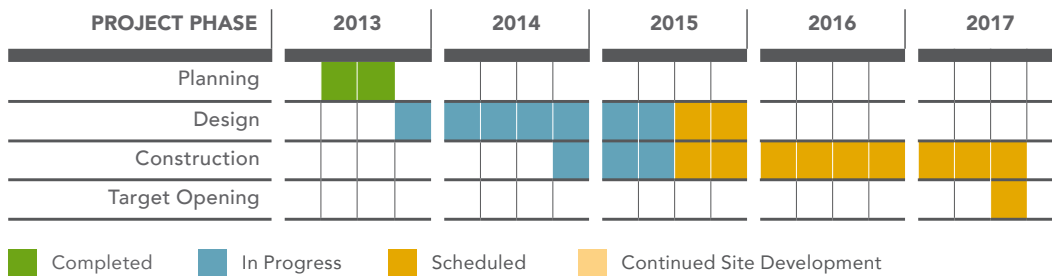

Booker T. Washington High School was constructed in 1958 in the northwest part of Houston. Booker T. Washington was named after the education pioneer and features a specialized program for students interested in the engineering professions. Funds allocated from the 2007 bond program will be used to maintain a safe and suitable learning environment until the new facility is constructed as part of the 2012 bond program.

- ✓ 21st century campus integrating technology and flexible spaces, allowing for large and small student-centered breakout areas.
- ✓ Natural light will be provided through the exterior windows at the learning centers and clerestories at many of the extended learning areas.
- ✓ New auditorium.
- ✓ The learning commons is dispersed throughout the building allowing for flexible learning environments within the neighborhoods and in the building's main atrium.
- ✓ Engineering and science laboratories have high bay interior space and direct access to exterior learning courtyards.
