IV. Final Exam Schedule

The final exam schedule has been circulated and is posted on the homepage. A question was raised regarding making camera/video mandatory. Dr. Mishlan answered that cameras are encouraged but not mandatory and teachers should exercise all best practices for test security, including Application questions (not rote memorization), multiple forms of tests, and following strict schedule for unlocking test during designated periods.

To help guide the work in second semester, the general consensus indicates a need for improvements in teacher consistency, clarity and communication.

VI. Semester Two

- a. The daily schedule will remain mostly unchanged for students, with the office hour period tacking on to student lunch period for face-to-face learners.
- b. In-Person Lunch/Office Hours—In-Person Students will have a longer lunch, providing flexibility to visit teachers on an as-needed basis. Teachers will not have students always present in their classrooms during the office hours segment, providing more privacy and making teachers more available to students and parents.
