- Hard deadline to register for the test is Nov. 6, 2020
- Register on PowerSchool
- Test date/time will be set based on number of students testing

 Entrance to any high school program is PENDING PROMOTION to the next grade level





Application Phases

- Phase 1:
 Sept. 19, 2020 to Nov. 6, 2020
 (deadline is midnight)
- Phase 2:
 Nov. 7, 2020 to Feb. 26, 2020

How To Apply Online

- Go to <u>HISDchoice.com</u>
- Create a login using an email you check frequently
- Search schools and programs
- Fill out application
- Electronically sign and submit



How To Apply Online

- Apply to a maximum of 10 programs
- Apply to a maximum of 5 magnet programs
- Update application at any time until the deadline (Nov. 6, 2020 at midnight)



How To Apply On Paper

- Go to <u>www.choosehisd.org</u>
- Download application
- Fill out application
- Follow directions to submit





The Lottery

- This is a Lottery (not merit-based)
- All qualified candidates are equal
- Results posted online by midnight on Jan. 28, 2021 (results also sent by U.S. mail)





The Lottery

- Deadline to accept your seat is Feb. 10, 2021
- Must provide proof of residency and signed Magnet Agreement by the deadline





Ranking Your Choices

- RANKING MATTERS
- System ranks schools in the order you apply
- Families need to change their ranking choices





Ranking Your Choices

- Families can change their ranking up to midnight on Nov. 6, 2020
- Ranking order has no effect on the Lottery
- Think carefully about your ranking





Ranking Your Choices

All schools ranked lower than an accepted school will be dropped





Ranking Example 1

Rank 2	School B	Not Qualified	Not Qualified
Rank 3	School C	Accepted	Accepted
Rank 4	School D	Accepted	** Dropped **
Rank 5	School E	Wait Listed	** Dropped **

Types of High Schools

- International Baccalaureate
 - Middle Years Programme
 - Diploma Programme
 - Career-Related Programme
- Cannot transfer to an IB school if you are zoned to one





Boundary Option Transfer

- If you are zoned to Wisdom you can apply to Westside and Lamar
- Based on home address and available space
- Lottery will apply if applications exceed available space



Space Available Transfer

- Option of transferring to a school designated as having extra space
- Transportation is NOT available
