- If you are applying to a **Vanguard Magnet program**, you must complete the **Vanguard Magnet application**. To obtain a copy of the Vanguard Magnet application, contact the Vanguard Magnet school you are interested in or download one from www.houstonisd.org/magnet.
- You will be notified by mail of the status of your application on **March 22, 2013**. No status updates can be given before this date.

 - First grading period of current report card
 - Proof of HISD residency (apartment rent receipt, utility bill receipt, or statement of residence)

- Must meet the criteria of an overall academic average of 78 and a conduct average of S based on the first grading period of the current school year and the previous year's complete report card to be scheduled for an audition.
- Once students meet the baseline criteria for auditioning, selection for the program is based solely on the audition results.
- Students must attend each scheduled audition. Students who do not audition will not qualify.
- Each school establishes its own audition procedures. Questions regarding these procedures or programs offered should be directed to the individual school.
- Some programs require students to audition in two areas; therefore, please select a first, second, and third focus area choice.
