- If you are applying to a Vanguard Magnet program, you must complete the Vanguard Magnet application. To obtain a copy of the Vanguard Magnet application, contact the Vanguard Magnet school you are interested in or download one from www.houstonisd.org/magnet.
- · You will be notified by mail of the status of your application on March 22, 2013. No status updates can be given before this date.

- · Once students meet the baseline criteria for auditioning, selection for the program is based solely on the audition results.
- Students must attend each scheduled audition. Students who do not audition will not qualify.
- Each school establishes its own audition procedures. Questions regarding these procedures or programs offered should be directed to the individual school.
- Some programs require students to audition in two areas; therefore, please select a first, second, and third focus area choice.
