<u>Applications</u> – there is still time to apply to 2 year and 4 year colleges, as well as the military.

The College Center can also provide guidance on entering the workforce.

#### Financial Assistance -

**FAFSA** – fafsa.gov Federal Student Aid application will need to be completed regardless of your financial abilities. Merit based scholarships will not be awarded if a FAFSA application is not on file.

Requires tax documentation and the application can be completed in about 20 minutes if the student brings it with them to the College Center.

**TASFA** – Texas Application for State Financial Aid application for non-citizens who are classified as Texas citizens

**Scholarships** – There are many scholarships still available.

- Award Letters should be arriving soon and many are already received.
- After May 1, universities assess scholarship award that are not utilized and will redistribute to students attending. Some require a 24 hour response to accept the scholarship. **Students should check their emails daily.**

#### f. Senior Finals and Exemptions

- May 20-22, 2020 are Senior class final exams. They are earlier than other grades to ensure students will graduate with their class
- Students may qualify to be exempt from finals IF they maintain a class grade and absence as below:
  - i. Grade of 90 or above AND 3 or less absences
  - ii. Grade of 80 or above AND 2 or less absences
  - iii. Grade of 70 or above **AND** 1 or less absence
- Students may opt to take the final to bring up their class grade. This is the grade that will go on their report card.
- Classes that have a Project Based Final will need to be completed; students may NOT opt out of project.

#### VII. GRADUATION All is very important so please read thoroughly

MAY 29, 2020 NRG ARENA 7:00PM

Students will receive a wristband to confirm they will graduate and to enter NRG Arena. Parents will need to ask students about this wristband!

Students will have ½ day school on May 29, 2020. This is not a skip day!

NRG ARENA:

Parents will take students at the designated time To Be Determined.

Parking is \$12 per vehicle. No Free Parking.

Parents are advised to stay once they drop students at NRG Arena.

Wheelchairs enter may possibly enter through same door as graduates, but it may be at regular time and not early with students.

## SEATING IS FIRST COME-FIRST SERVE

#### NRG ARENA RULES: Heights High School and HISD can not change these

- No Flowers, balloons, noise makers, posters. You will be asked to throw them out before entering the building.
- No Seat saving for family still in line for the Security check.
- ALL people will be required to go through the standard security check upon entering NRG Arena.
  - Metal detector
  - Purse/bag check

This process significantly slows all people entering and can take a long period of time to wait in line. Please consider this as it applies to small children and the elderly.

There is a narrow window of time from when the doors open to when the ceremony begins. *CEREMONY WILL START* promptly at 7:00pm regardless if families are still trying to get in through security.

• Students are NOT allowed to have phones. Staff collects about 30+ phones each year from students trying to sneak them in.

 Parents are NOT allowed to wait in the lobby for their student following the ceremony. It will be dark and crowded when you exit the arena. Please coordinate a meeting point with your student prior to dropping off at NRG Arena.

Class of 2020 has approximately 520 students. NRG Arena capacity (seats) approximately 5000 people. Fire code will not allow NRG to admit more than the capacity. It is advised to consider pertinent family members only attend.

Ms. Hampton and/or Mr. Idlebird will attend an HISD meeting in March 2020 to further discuss graduation. They will provide more information following that meeting like the

time for students to be at NRG Arena, wheelchair entrances, and other items.
