Herod Elementary Enrichment Program Policies and Procedures

PAYMENT. Payment for all vendor classes will be made directly to the vendor. Please review vendor flyers for more information. Herod teacher run and MadScience enrichment classes will be paid to Herod Elementary. Payments are accepted at www.schoolpay.com. Cash, checks and money orders are accepted in-person only. Checks are payable to Herod Elementary. The first payment for non-vendor classes (1/2 of tuition plus supply fees) is due by August 26, 2022. The remaining balance is due Friday, October 14, 2022.

CLASS CANCELLATION. If your child is enrolled in an Herod Enrichment class and it is canceled due to lack of enrollment, a full refund for that class will be issued.

NO AFTER-CLASS SUPERVISION. Absolutely no supervision is provided after enrichment classes are dismissed. All children must be picked up and signed out promptly when class is dismissed. After the 2nd late pick-up, your child will no longer be eligible to attend the program.

CONDUCT/DISCIPLINE. In order to provide a safe and nurturing environment in which to teach Enrichment classes, students must exhibit appropriate behavior. Students enrolled in Enrichment classes are expected to follow the HISD Code of Conduct. Students who fail to conduct themselves according to this standard will be given a warning and their parents will be notified of their misconduct. Continued misconduct will result in notification to Herod administrators and/or suspension from the Enrichment Program. Students suspended from the Enrichment program for misconduct will not be entitled to a refund of any tuition, fees, or registration paid.
