Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope this letter finds you and your family in good health and high spirits. As we embark on a new academic year at Milby High School, we would like to take this opportunity to remind you of our school's dress code policy. We believe that maintaining a positive and respectful learning environment is crucial for the academic success and personal development of our students.

Our dress code policy is designed to ensure that students dress appropriately, maintaining a balance between personal expression and a respectful appearance that aligns with the professional atmosphere of our educational institution. We kindly request your support and cooperation in ensuring that your child adheres to the following guidelines:

1. Tops:

- Shirts or Polos must be a solid Royal Blue, Gold, Black, or White.
- Tops should cover the shoulders, chest, and midriff always.
- Tank tops, crop tops, and spaghetti straps are not permitted.
- Shirts with offensive language, images, or symbols are prohibited.
- Spirit shirts ARE permitted.

2. Bottoms:

- Navy, Blue, Black Jeans, Khakis and Sweatpants ONLY.
- No tears or rips above the knee.
- No shorts, full-length pants are required.
- No leggings, yoga pants, pajamas or tight-fitting pants are allowed.
- Sagging pants or trousers that expose undergarments are not permitted.

3. Footwear:

- No house shoes

4. Headgear:

- No hats, caps, beanies, ski masks, sunglasses, headscarves or durags.

5. Outside Deliveries:

- No outside food deliveries from any, including UberEATS and Door Dash.

6. Tools for Success:

- ID Badges MUST always be visible.
- Bring a charged laptop to school daily.
- Clear or mesh backpacks ONLY. All others prohibited.
- Small purses (5'x5') for personal items are allowed but are subject to searches.
- Cell phones are NOT to be used during class.

Please note that these guidelines are not exhaustive, and the school administration reserves the right to address any attire that is deemed inappropriate or disruptive to the learning environment. Students who violate the dress code policy will be subject to appropriate disciplinary action, which may include changing clothes, temporary exclusion from class, or other consequences outlined in the school's disciplinary policy.

We kindly request your assistance in reviewing the strictly enforced dress code policy with your child and ensuring that they are aware of the expectations. By working together, we can create a positive environment that promotes focus, respect, and inclusivity within our school community.

Estimado padre o tutor,

Espero que al recibir este comunicado usted y su familia se encuentren con buena salud. En la preparatoria Milby High School nos estamos preparando para el nuevo año escolar y queremos aprovechar esta oportunidad para informarle sobre el código de vestimenta que adoptaremos. Es imprescindible mantener un ambiente de positivismo y respeto para alcanzar el desarrollo personal y éxito académico de cada uno de nuestros alumnos.

Nuestro código de vestimenta está diseñado para que nuestros estudiantes mantengan un balance entre su expresión personal y apariencia profesional adecuada para nuestra institución educativa. Pedimos su apoyo y cooperación asegurándose que su hijo/a siga las siguientes reglas:

1. Blusas/Camisas:

- Camisetas o camisas con cuello estilo polo lisas de color azul rey, amarillo, negro o blanco.
- Las blusas deben cubrir los hombros, pecho y cintura todo el tiempo.
- No se permiten las camisetas ni blusas de tirantes o que muestren el área de la cintura u ombligo.
- No se permiten camisetas con palabras, imágenes o símbolos ofensivos.
- Las camisetas con logotipo de Milby son permitidas.

2. Pantalones:

- Sólo se permiten pantalones de mezclilla, caqui o pantalones deportivos (pants).
- No se permiten pantalones rotos arriba de la rodilla.
- No se permiten pantalones cortos.
- Si se permiten pantalones negros.
- No se permiten mallones, pantalones para yoga, pijamas ni pantalones apretados.
- No se permiten pantalones flojos que dejen ver la ropa interior.

3. Zapatos:

- No se permiten las pantuflas.

4. Accesorios:

- No se permiten las gorras, sombreros, lentes de sol, pasamontañas, ni pañoletas.

5. Entregas:

- No se permiten las entregas de comida incluidas las entregas de UberEATS y Door Dash.

6. Buenos Hábitos:

- El gafete de identificación debe de estar visible a toda hora.
- Traigan las computadoras cargadas a diario.
- Las mochilas SÓLO pueden ser transparentes o de malla. No se permite ningún otro tipo.
- Se permiten las bolsas chicas de uso personal (5'x5') pueden ser revisadas.
- No se permite el uso de teléfono celular durante clase.

Sepa por favor que éstas no son las únicas normas y que la administración de la escuela tiene el derecho de detener a cualquier estudiante que esté vestido de manera que interrumpa el proceso de aprendizaje. Los estudiantes que violen el código de vestimenta recibirán consecuencias tales como tener que cambiarse la ropa, exclusión temporal de la clase o las consecuencias del código de conducta del distrito escolar de Houston.

The standard dress code is expected of ALL students daily.
Its implementation will increase safety and maximize a learning environment that reduces distractions.

What IS allowed?

Tops:



- Solid colored shirts/Polos (ROYAL BLUE, GOLD, WHITE, BLACK)
- Spirit Shirts

Bottoms:



- Khakis
- Navy Blue Pants
- Blue, Black Jeans (NO rips above Knee)

Student ID:

- MUST be worn and visible.

Backpacks:

- MUST clear or mesh.
- Small purses 5'x5' (Subject to search)

What IS NOT allowed?

Tops:

- NO sleeveless shirts
- NO Crop-tops
- NO Low-cut shirts

Shoes:

- NO House Shoes

Bottoms:

- NO Tights/Yoga Pants
- NO Shorts
- NO Pajamas Bottoms
- NO White Jeans
- NO Rips above the Knee
- Pants should be worn at the natural waistline.
- **NO** exposed underwear
- Full length pants are required.

Hats/Misc:

- NO Hats/Caps
- NO Beanies
- NO Ski Masks
- NO Sunglasses
- NO Headscarve/Durags.

Additional Info:

No outside deliveries are permitted.
Cell phones are **NOT** to be used during class.
