### **Homecoming Court Campaign Guidelines and Rules:**

#### **1. SOCIAL MEDIA:**

- a. Students ARE allowed to post information to promote themselves.
- b. Students ARE NOT allowed to post negative attacks.
- c. **Any student who does not conform to social media guidelines may lose their privilege to participate in Homecoming Court.**
- d. **Students are allowed to send Flip grids/videos to librarian to post on school's website**

- 2. Homecoming Court Representative Campaign Dates:** Campaigning will take place from **Monday, 12/7/20 to Wednesday, 12/09/20**. Any candidate who begins campaigning before this date (including on Social Media) will be disqualified. Students **must** remove all campaign materials from the building by **Thursday 12/10/20, by 3:25 PM**.

#### **3. Campaign Materials:**

- ✓ Students are allowed to hang up posters and distribute flyers to the student body at large as long as it does not interfere with classes. Website materials must be sent to the school's librarian.
- ✓ Students may NOT post any campaign material in the restroom or in classrooms.
- ✓ **Students may NOT distribute candy or other edible items to the student body.**
- ✓ Candidates may not be excused from class to campaign or hang up materials.
- ✓ Masks must be worn, and social distancing is mandatory.
