- 1. Leader Appraisal System
  - a. SDMC Committee view the LEAD System video 2023-2024 LEAD Voiceover

- 2. Student enrollment
  - a. We are over projection. Our projection was 712 and as of today, we have 738 students.
- 3. Budget

- a. Ms. Epps informed the committee that the budget analyst stated that will not receive additional funds for overage. The projection of 712 was based on the campus trend for the past few years. In the past, positions added after preliminary budget was advanced to you. This year, it was debited right away, which resulted in starting the school year in the red. At the budget meeting, we will not reconcile. Ms. Epps plans to request another budget meeting to discuss the impact as a Non-Title 1 campus. As a result, the counselor position had to be closed.
- b. The campus will review funding for student resources such as Imagine Language and after-school tutoring.
