• Budget for 22-23 School Year

District is looking to move to an FTE model; we currently have a decentralized budget; FTE is a fixed model. Once the district has finalized the plan, Ms. Epps will share with the SDMC. The committee asked if PTO could pay for full-time contract positions in the event we do not have enough allocated under the new model. Ms. Epps explained that the only positions the PTO can help support are hourly positions and district approved contracted positions.
