School Budget 24-25

- 1. Funding is adequate for all day-to-day operations and supplies.
- 2. Field trip funding line: We will no longer be able to ask for funds for field trips. We have made budget allocations for the upcoming school year, so this should not be problematic.
- 3. Esser Funds are no available. This school we used funds for HB1416 tutorials which is required for any student who did not score at least "Meet" STAAR. We will still be able to provide HB 1416 tutoring next year.

4. We are adding a counselor position and a clerk position for the 24-25 school year. Positions 24-25

- 1. All teacher, ancillary, interventions, office, administration are secured. We are not making cuts to any positions.
- 2. All positions are filled except kindergarten (1), first (1) and counselor.

After School Care 24 – 25

- 1. We have a new vendor for after school care; iKids. We will continue to house the program on the campus, but iKids will run the day-to-day operations. iKids provides a variety of options and flexibility for after school care. iKids is a district approved vendor.
- Safety & School Maintenance
 - 1. PADRES Workday Saturday. They will work on the following areas:
 - Area near shed
 - Replace air purifier filters
 - Place a tarp on the T-Building with leaks.

- 2. Enrollment numbers for 24-25? We are currently on par with our same enrollment for the upcoming school year, but we have seen an increase in grades 3-5.
