### **SDMC Meeting Minutes**

**Thursday, April 25, 2019**

**Meeting called to order at 3:18 p.m.**

- **New SDMC membership requirement - Special Education member**
  - Ms. Epps read the new requirement that SDMCs have non-voting representation from a Special Education instructor.
  - Kendra Salas has been appointed the Special Education representative to the Roberts Elementary SDMC.
- **Update on Modified TADS**
  - The proposal for the modified TADS process presented to the SDMC in February has been approved to begin in the 2019-2020 school year.
  - Under the current system, teachers meet with their appraisers 3 times a year. Under the new modified system, teachers who meet the requirements may opt to meet with their appraisers 2 times a year.
- **Budget Updates**
  - The 2019-2020 budget has been finalized. For our campus, one position had been eliminated, and contract time has been reduced for three other positions.
- **SDMC Survey – required for all members**
  - Ms. Epps has sent the link. SDMC Members should complete the survey by May 26<sup>th</sup>.
- **Summer School**
  - Summer school will take place at Mark Twain Elementary. We are unable to host due to Greenbriar construction going far, far over its scheduled time.
  - Due to the budget reductions, summer school will only be offered for students who have not met promotion standards.
- **Security/Safety/Building Concerns**
  - Over the long Spring Holiday weekend, the power breaker to Cornelius/Hoffman's T-buildings was flipped off, and profanity was graffitied on tables around the area. It was cleaned up the same day.
  - The parking lot gates have been damaged by people triggering them to open and close repeatedly with their bikes, which results in them getting stuck halfway open.
  - A lot of trash has been left on the grounds after weekend parties.
  - The suggested solution is more signs in more locations: asking people to clean up after themselves; to respect school property; and stating that the school grounds are monitored by video surveillance.
