Hello, Pin Oak Middle School Community:

Please allow me to take this opportunity to provide further clarification about the instructional opportunities and choices available to each of our families.

On Monday, October 19, 2020, face-to-face instruction begins for all students in Houston ISD. It is the sole responsibility and decision of each parent to select the best option for their child.

As a parent, you do have the option to opt out of face-to-face instruction. While your initial selection is valid for the entire school year, you may choose to change your selection after each six-week grading period. Your selection must be made by this Friday, September 25, 2020.

To clarify, during in-person learning:

- Certified teachers will provide instruction in the classroom.
- Physical distancing will be enforced with reduced class sizes.
- Physical distancing signage will be placed around the campus.
- Personal protective equipment (PPE) will be distributed to each campus on a weekly and monthly
- A health screening app will be used by employees for check-in.
- Masks must always be worn properly by students and staff.
- Social activities and campus movement will be limited.
