## Band

The marching and concert bands are designed to develop the techniques of full band and ensemble playing through the performance of a variety of music. Student involvement is required for all types of public performances (competitions, festivals, halftime shows, parades, concerts, and other public engagements). After school practice is required to be part of these activities. A beginning band class is also available for students wanting to play an instrument.



## Percussion

Percussion is a curriculum class in which the students will develop technique and skills relating to percussion performance. Students will be involved in drum line, percussion ensemble, and concert band.



## Jazz Band

Our award winning jazz band is designed to familiarize the student with the various styles and types of jazz / stage band music. Jazz band is a curriculum class that meets daily during the assigned period. Students must be enrolled in band or have director approval.
