Please review and adhere to the following procedures related to our early dismissal days:

- ♦ Parker Elementary School will dismiss ALL STUDENTS at 12:00 pm. on November 8th, 2019 Magnet classes and all afterschool care activities will be canceled.
- ♦ All PreK and PALS Students will be dismissed at the front of the building on Stillbrook at 11:45 a.m.
- All Kinder & 1st Grade car riders will be dismissed at the front of the building at our carpool lane at 12:00 pm.
- ♦ Car riders in grades 2nd 5th will be dismissed at the Willowbend gate at 12:00 pm.
- Day care & bus riders will be dismissed at 12:00 pm. from the cafeteria.
- If you have more than one child and would like to have siblings report to the same dismissal gate, please communicate this to your child's teachers. It is preferable for the older sibling to go to the younger sibling's gate.
- ♦ Wait patiently in the drop-off/pick-up area. Cutting in front of another car is dangerous. Please help us keep all of our children safe.
- Do not block residents' driveways. Please be courteous to our neighbors.
- Your child's safety is our primary concern. Please support us in our efforts to keep your child safe. Your patience is greatly appreciated (keep in mind we are dismissing almost 900 students).




