

Parker Elementary School EARLY DISMISSAL INFORMATION

Please review and adhere to the following procedures related to our early dismissal days:

- Parker Elementary School will dismiss ALL STUDENTS at 11:30 a.m. On January 18th. Magnet classes and all afterschool care activities will be canceled.
- All PreK and PALS Students will be dismissed at the front of the building on Stillbrook at 11:15 a.m.
- All Kinder & 1st Grade car riders will be dismissed on the CARPOOL LANE at 11:30 a.m.
- Car riders in grades 2nd 5th will be dismissed at the Willowbend gate at 11:30 a.m.
- Day care & bus riders will be dismissed at 11:30 a.m. on the bus lane.
- If you have more than one child and would like to have siblings report to the same dismissal gate, please communicate this to your child's teachers. It is preferable for the older sibling to go to the younger sibling's gate.
- Wait patiently in the drop-off/pick-up area. Cutting in front of another car is dangerous. Please help us keep all of our children safe.
- Do not block residents' driveways. Please be courteous to our neighbors.
- Your child's safety is our primary concern. Please support us in our efforts to keep your child safe. Your patience is greatly appreciated (keep in mind we are dismissing almost 900 students).

The required Parker Elementary Standard Mode of Dress is:

- **Tops** (long or short sleeves) red, white, or navy **solid/plain** shirt or a Parker spirit shirt.
 - > Any undershirt must comply with red, white, or navy color scheme.
- Bottoms pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers MUST be solid/plain khaki, black, navy, or denim.
 - Shorts, skirts and jumpers MUST have lower hems reach the fingertips of the student wearing them when their arms are down.
 - Leggings MUST be worn with shorts, skirts, or jumpers and comply with the color scheme of solid/plain white, black, or navy.
 - > Athletic wear is NOT allowed, no shorts or pants.
- **Pullovers, sweaters, etc**. any of these that are worn during the day must comply with the color scheme of solid/plain red, white, black, navy, or denim.
- **Coats** for outdoor activities may be of any color or style.
- Other items no hats may be worn indoors and shoes must be closedtoed.
- Friday will be **college day**, any college shirt may be worn or the above standard mode of dress. (no professional sports teams wear allowed)
- Non-uniform days for all students will be picture days and other designated days.

Failure to abide by dress code may result with:

- Conduct Grade issue in Communication Folder
 - Assigned Detention for chronic issues
