Dear Parents,

We regret to inform you that Houston ISD will no longer offer the flu vaccine clinics this school year, as our flu shot provider, Healthy Schools, has discontinued the program.

Unfortunately, low turnout across the country in previous years, and lower than expected parent consents for this year's upcoming flu clinics, has made the program unsustainable. The growing cost of running flu vaccine clinics has made it impossible for Healthy Schools to continue the program in Texas this year, and in the future.

We recommend that parents reach out to their local health department or child's pediatrician to inquire about an alternative cost-free flu vaccine or visit the CDC flu shot finder website to locate local flu vaccine providers. Our mobile clinic partners such as Texas Children's Hospital Mobile and Harris Health Troubleshooters along with our School Based Clinic partners are also available to provide free flu and other vaccines to eligible students.

Estimados padres:

Lamentamos informarles que Houston ISD dejará de ofrecer la vacuna contra la gripe este año debido a que nuestro proveedor, *Healthy Schools*, ha cancelado el programa.

Desafortunadamente, el número de personas interesadas en los últimos años ha sido bajo en todo el país. Además, el número de cartas de autorización de los padres para la vacunación ha sido inferior al previsto para este año y por lo tanto el programa se ha vuelto insostenible. Por otra parte, el creciente costo de estas campañas de vacunación contra la gripe impide que *Healthy Schools* continúe ofreciendo el programa en Texas este año y en el futuro.

Recomendamos a los padres que se comuniquen con el departamento de salud pública o con el consultorio del pediatra de su hijo para informarse de opciones gratuitas de vacunación contra la gripe. Otra posibilidad es visitar el sitio web de CDC para buscar proveedores de la vacuna de la gripe de su localidad. Nuestros socios de la salud con clínicas móviles, como *Texas Children's Hospital Mobile* y *Harris Health Troubleshooters*, junto con los proveedores asociados de clínicas escolares, también pueden administrar la vacuna contra la gripe y otras de forma gratuita a estudiantes que reúnan las condiciones.
