Tim Glover has taught at the High School for Performing and Visual Arts full-time since 2013. He has received commissions from the City of Houston, Houston Metro Light Rail, The Children's Museum Houston, the University of Houston and recently, "Light Garden" at the WOW Roundabout in Houston, Texas. As a board member of Buffalo Bayou Art Park he was instrumental in bringing the 18th International Sculpture Conference to Houston in 2000. Mr. Glover has received numerous grants and honors for his professional achievements including the distinguished Pollack-Krasner Award and the Presidential Scholars Program, Teacher Recognition Award from the U.S. Department of Education and several artist fellowships from the Houston Arts Alliance. His sculptures have been exhibited across the state of Texas, the United States and in several foreign countries. Glover's work is in public, private and corporate collections in the US. He recently had a major retrospective exhibition at the LHUCA in Lubbock in the summer of 2016.
