THE APPLICATION PROCESS

For Carnegie Vanguard high School

How to apply

STEP 1: Fill out an application online (a link to the application is available on CVHS website under quick links).

Deadline is December 7, 2018!

STEP 2: HISD GT status

If your student is already GT by HISD

APPLYSUBMIT

NO DOCUMENTS ARE NEEDED.
STUDENT IS ALREADY QUALIFIED.

If your student is NOT GT by HISD

- Request testing to your HISD Zoned school by December 8th
- 2. Upload your last year's final report card on the application by January 23rd 2019.
- Request using the online system
 <u>a teacher recommendation by January 23rd</u> 2019.

Step 3: GT Testing (if needed).

IOWA = 4 hours: Math and English

CogAT = 30 min: non verbal test

Testing location

If applying to 9th grade please request testing to your HISD zoned MIDDLE school

If applying to 10th grade, please request testing to your HISD zone HIGH school

Testing dates

- Each school has scheduled their own dates for the GT testing.
- Please contact your zoned school GT coordinator to schedule the test and confirm the testing dates.
- The testing window for GT is from 12/1/18 to 1/12/19.

Additional information about testing

■ No other tests are acceptable.

We can only accept tests if they were taken on HISD premises and are dated from the current school year.

STEP 4: Last year report card

Upload on the online application:

- If applying to the 9TH GRADE : Upload your 7TH grade FINAL REPORT CARD
- If applying to the 10TH GRADE: Upload your 8TH grade FINAL REPORT CARD.

If you cannot upload it please email your documents to <u>Imounni@houstonisd.org</u>

Step 5: Request a teacher recommendation

Option 1:

On the online application, enter your child's current core teacher's name and email address. The teacher will then submit it back to us.

Option 2:

Print a paper copy from the Vanguard Magnet application:

- Current Core teacher complete the paper recommendation and return it to you in a sealed envelope with his/her signature across the seal.
- Submit the sealed Core Teacher Recommendation directly to me!
- Option 3:

The Core teacher may also scan the completed Teacher Recommendation and send it

to me directly at limoustonisd.org.

All Teacher Recommendations must be submitted by January 23, 2019.

Emails will be sent:

- To confirm **application submission**.
- To notify you if **documentation is required**.
- To send you **reminders.**

Pick an email you check often!

Step 6: Ranking!!!

■ 5 magnet schools .

How to rank them: Order of importance!

Ranking does not affect the lottery!

But it does affect your school's statuses after the lottery

Ranking information

■ The deadline to rank is **DECEMBER 7TH** !

After this date you <u>WILL NOT</u> be able to change your ranking!

Make sure to rank your schools according to where your child wants to go!

Example

- Rank 1= CVHS
- Rank 2= Bellaire HS
- Rank 3= DeBakey HS
- Rank 4= Westbury HS
- Rank 5= Heights HS

Scenario1/scenario 2

Scenario #1

Rank 1= CVHS accepted
 Rank 2= Bellaire HS
 Rank 3= DeBakey HS
 Rank 4= Westbury HS
 Rank 5= Heights HS

- 1. You have until <u>April 5th</u> to let us know you want the seat otherwise your seat will be dropped.
- 2. Provide a Proof of Residence
- 3. Sign the Entrance Agreement

Scenario #2:

Rank 1= CVHS waitlisted and ALIVE!

- Rank 2= Bellaire HS waitlisted and ALIVE!
- Rank 3= DeBakey HS accepted
- Rank 4= Westbury HS
- Rank 5= Heights HS

You <u>MUST accept</u> your seat at Debakey HS; it will not drop you from your higher ranked choice!

Lottery/notification

> In February / March : calculate the matrices

March: Lottery is run with all the qualified applicants.

Thursday, March 21, 2019: Notifications

Step 7: Accept or decline!

Parents have until **Friday April, 5 2019** to make a decision.

3 contact attempts : 2 emails and a phone call.

<u>If no answer by April 5th= declined seat</u>

Waitlist management after April 5th

- We will start moving students from the waitlist on April 8th.
- If you are called from the waitlist usually on a <u>Monday, you will have until Friday</u> of the same week to let us know if you want the seat or not.
- After the 3 points of contacts (2 emails and a call) without an answer we will drop your seat and move on to the next person on the waitlist.
- We moved the waitlist until <u>one week before school</u> <u>starts.</u>

What about transportation?

- HISD guarantees transportation to all magnet schools (for students accepted to that school).
- Transportation has been changed to a HUB system.
- Please be aware that the first weeks of school, the transportation department often adjusts and changes the routes.

To summarize:

Step 1: Apply online and submit before December 7th 2018

- Step 2: Confirm GT status
- <u>Step 3 if not GT</u>: Testing (request before December 8th)
- Step 4 if not GT: Upload last year's final report card (by 01/23/19)
- Step 5 if not GT: Request teacher recommendation (by 01/23/19)
- Step 6: Ranking before December 7th 2018
- <u>Step 7</u>: After notification accept or decline seat before April 5th 2019 and provide necessary documents.
