#### GIFTED AND TALENTED - VANGUARD PROGRAM

The Houston Independent School District provides a program for gifted and talented students. The Vanguard G/T program is designed to meet the needs of G/T students in grades K-12 by providing a homogeneous environment for students to work with their cognitive peers.

Bush offers the Vanguard program in grades kindergarten through fifth. All kindergartners are universally assessed. Students identified through this universal assessment enter the Vanguard program and receive services starting in late March or early April. Eligibility for the program is determined by classroom performance, standardized test scores, teacher recommendation, and specialized testing.
