

#### May 19 & 26 STAAR Testing Dates

Third - fifth grade students will be participating in online STAAR testing at Bush Elementary during the month of May. All in-person students are required to take the exam and virtual students have the option to come in and take the online STAAR assessment.

In order to adhere to social distancing and test security guidelines, we will need every Bush teacher to administer the STAAR on the following dates. This means all in-person PK - second grade students will be at home on these days for asynchronous learning.

Wednesday, May 19 Wednesday, May 26\*

\*In addition, all in-person third and fourth grade students will be at home on Wednesday, May 26 for asynchronous learning.

We're providing this early notice so parents have time to plan for child care coverage on these days. The teachers will not be providing live instruction on these days as they'll be administering and monitoring the third - fifth grade students as they take the STAAR assessment. PK - second grade students as well as virtual third - fifth grade students that choose not take the STAAR will complete lessons in Imagine Literacy and Imagine Math by 2:30 p.m. to count as present for the day. Each grade level will notify their students of the required time necessary to meet the attendance requirement for these days.

<u>Here's an overview of who will be at Bush Elementary on these specific May dates.</u>

Wednesday, May 19 - Only third, fourth, and fifth graders at Bush.

Wednesday, May 26 - Only fifth graders at Bush.

## May 28 At-Home Asynchronous Instructional Day

According to guidance provided by the Texas Education Agency (TEA), districts may apply for a waiver for spring 2021 that allows a district to change a traditional school day to an asynchronous instruction day to provide additional planned teacher professional development or preparation days.

The district was approved by the HISD Board of Education during the April regular board meeting to apply for this waiver from the state to offer asynchronous instruction for students and teacher professional development on **Friday, May 28**.

As a result, all students will participate in at-home virtual learning on Friday, May 28.

#### Morning Carpool Quick Tips

The morning carpool lane is moving a bit slower now that we have added more in-person students. In order to keep the drop off lane moving smoothly, please remember the following tips:

- As you enter the carpool lane, make sure your child has their mask on, has their backpack on and lunchbox is ready to go.
- If your child is not able to exit the car independently, please remain in the carpool line
  until you are at the front of the line. People stopping to help their children out of the car in
  the middle of the line are slowing everyone down. Also, have your children practice exiting
  the car by themselves. We are so proud of all of our students who have mastered this
  skill this year!
- Do not stop to drop off your children as you enter the carpool lane. Pull all the way up as far as you can in the line and then let them off.

If we all work together, our carpool lane will move quickly and everyone will enter the building safely and in a timely manner.

#### PK Lottery for Bush Elementary

The deadline to register for the PK lottery for next school year ended on April 30. The Bush Elementary PK program is populated from an HISD run lottery. We have almost 50 PK aged siblings of currently enrolled Bush students in our lottery. These children will be the only children in the lottery for the 22 Bush PK spots. HISD schools are allowed to give preference to the siblings of the currently enrolled students.

HISD, <u>not Bush Elementary</u>, will contact the families via email to notify them of receiving one of the 22 spots or their official number on the waiting list. HISD will notify families by Thursday, May 20 by 11:59 p.m. In this communication, the next steps for accepting a position or the wait list number will be shared.
