#### HISD CELL PHONE POLICY

The use of cell phones or any other unapproved electronic devices by students or test administrators in a testing environment is not permitted. Procedures regarding cell phones during testing include:

- Student cell phones and other unapproved electronic devices shall be collected by the test administrator prior to testing and returned to the owners after testing has been completed for the day.
- Campuses must post signs reminding students about the telecommunications rules prior to any district or state test administration.
- Prior to the start of the first major test administration in the spring, test administrators must read the "HISD Electronic Device Advisory Statement" shown below to all test participants.
- After the statement is read to students, all students will be required to sign the statement form.

## HISD ELECTRONIC DEVICE ADVISORY STATEMENT

"As per the Texas Education Agency (TEA) and Houston ISD, the use of cell phones and other personal electronic devices during testing is not permitted. I understand that I must power off my electronic device(s) and turn it in to the Test Administrator to hold until ALL students have completed the test. Being in possession of any electronic device(s) will be reason to have my test picked up and NOT SCORED. I understand that I will then have to turn in my phone, and that disciplinary action will be taken by campus administration."

#### DRESS CODE INFORMATION

The Bush Elementary Shared Decision Making Committee (BEC) voted to revise the dress code for 2015-2016. Beginning <a href="next">next</a> school year, all tights or leggings worn under skirts, jumpers, skorts or shorts must be solid red, white, khaki or navy. In addition, leggings may not be worn as pants - only under skirts or jumpers. We wanted to give our parents advance notice of this slight change for those of you who may be doing some early shopping for next year.

Please remember that our current Bush dress code states that long sleeved shirts worn under uniform shirts must be solid red, white or navy. Also, any jackets worn in the classrooms or anywhere inside the school building must be solid red, white or navy as well. Jackets worn outdoors may be of any color.

#### Here are some Family Picnic Tips:

- If you are bringing fast food for lunch, make sure you have enough time because fast food restaurants in the area will be busy.

  - Do not block driveways.
