September

- Discuss post high school plans with the College Center

- Get to know the college representatives
- Register for SAT / ACT
- Send your SAT / ACT scores to colleges
- Create an account with Applytexas.org or Commonapp.org
- o Complete your admissions essays
- Consider early action, early decision, and regular decision

October

- Begin submitting college applications
- Request your transcripts through Bellaire.org
- o Request your letters of recommendation
- Submit your SAT / ACT scores to colleges
- o Attend College Fair on Oct. 1st
- o Apply for FAFSA / TASFA on Oct. 1st
- o Apply for scholarships @ Cash4Cards

November

- Attend Financial Aid events
- Apply for scholarships
- Submit college applications

December

- o DECEMBER 1 DEADLINE
- o Apply for scholarships
- Look up housing options for your collegesapply if available

January

- Wait for your Student Aid Report (SAR)
- Submit copies of acceptance letters and SAR to the College Center
- o Apply for scholarships

February

- Look for Reasons to love your colleges
- Submit copies of your financial award package from EACH university to the College Center
- Try to visit the campuses before you make a final decision
- Apply for scholarships

March

- Complete your financial aid files
- Submit copies of acceptance letters, SAR, and financial aid award packages to the College Center
- o Apply for scholarships

April

- Accept Financial Aid and Scholarship Award Offers
- o Return necessary forms to your colleges

May

- SENIOR DECISION DAY! Commit to your school
- Submit copies of acceptance letters, SAR, and financial aid award packages to the College Center
- Sign up for Orientation
- Search for final scholarship opportunities

June
