 - SDMC Points of Consideration
 - We would like more weight on the categories that we have control over such as Quality of Instruction and Planning and Professionalism.
 - While Student Achievement is linked to the quality of instruction, it is out of our control how a student may test. There are factors beyond our control that could affect a student's performance.
 - Including the Campus Action Plan allows accountability on everyone's part. Campus Action Plan needs to be communicated with staff
 - SDMC Rankings
 - Choice 1: Option A: Quality of instruction 45%, Student Achievement 30% and Campus Action Plan 10%
 - We felt that this allowed teachers to have a greater percentage of control.
 - Choice 2: Option B: Quality of instruction 45%, Student Achievement 35% and Campus Action Plan 5%
 - Choice 3: Option C: Quality of instruction 40%, Student Achievement 35% and Campus Action Plan 10%
 - Choice 4- Option D: student surveys 5%
 - Choice 5- Option E: Student surveys 10%
