- Questions and Concerns
 - Concerns: Less observations for teachers who are 4's. Ms. Jennings stated that regarding observations, it's
 important to have multiple observations in order for appraisers to see all criteria. Gives opportunity for teachers
 to improve on their observation score.
 - How did first round of EOY testing go? Teachers were testing or discussing scores. In the G-Wing there
 were no monitors to relieve test administrators. Ms. Jennings stated the weather was too cold. There was a
 suggestion to strategically plan to assign extended time takers in same area according to grade level to avoid
 distractions. Have more administrators monitor during testing time.
 - Are Mr. Knittle's announcements working? Yes announcements are working to rush students to class.
 Announcements made are specific for Hall Sweeps.

- Career Day: Could've been announced sooner to invite others. Ensure all teachers are included to invite speakers.
