

Goal

Grading procedures:

- <u>Major Assessments</u>: Each cycle will have a minimum of three major grades. If a Project is assigned, it will also count as a major grade.
- Minor Grades: There will be a
 MINIMUM of two minor grades per
 week. These may include quizzes,
 activities, and homework practice.
- *Tests & Retests: If a student makes a 70% or below on a test, there will be one opportunity to retest. This retest grade will replace the failing test grade with a grade up to a 70%. Students should do corrections and attend one tutorial prior to retake. Retests will be held on certain days set by the teacher. No other make-ups allowed.
- <u>*Late Assignments</u>: Late work will be accepted no later than two days past the due date for a maximum grade of 70%. Grade will be a <u>zero</u> after that. No exceptions!
- *Academic Dishonesty: Students will receive <u>zero</u> for the assignment and a disciplinary referral if found cheating in any form.







Absentee policy:

Students are responsible for contacting the teacher when absent and review the Canvas course for missed lessons, activities, and assignments. Make sure to check Canvas every day to prevent falling behind in the course work.

If you missed a Major Assessment, you must make it up during lunch within the first two days after you come back.
