PHOTOGRAPHY INTENSIVE

JUNE 9TH - 16TH 2018



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This one-week digital workshop is for students interested in exploring the rich humanistic traditions of fine art and street photography, while learning how to develop a personal style of shooting, using all sources of light, to create a stunning photographic portfolio.

Compelling fine art and documentary work demands a photographer's strong connection with his or her subject. In this course, the instructor teaches students how to make that connection and develop a personal style of shooting. Students will spend much of their time exploring and photographing the rich daily life of Spoleto, Italy, creating a portfolio of 15-20 images on a theme of their choice about Spoleto or the life of the city.

The instructor will discuss technique, intent, composition and the creative use of the camera and lens. Participants will receive daily feedback on their works-in-progress from the instructor and during peer group discussions. The final day of the workshop will culminate in an art exhibition.

TECHNOLOGY & CAMERA GEAR

This workshop is conducted using digital cameras and iPhones. Students will need to know how to download their digital images to a folder each evening so that their day's work can be brought to class the next day on a flash drive or external hard drive for the daily review with the instructor.

Students may work with a DSLR camera, or Mirrorless Interchangeable Lens camera (such as a Sony Alpha 6000). Two lenses are recommended, such as a 17-35mm zoom, or 24mm, 28mm, 35mm, or 50mm lens. In order to shoot comfortably in low light situations, it will be preferable that students have a lens that has a wide aperture such as 1.4, 1.8, 2, or 2.8. iPhones are welcome as a secondary 'camera body'.

Students should bring several memory cards (at least 1 G cards are recommended), a battery charger and extra batteries. Your laptop should have Adobe Photoshop CC (Creative Cloud) which can be downloaded on a monthly basis. Please make sure the software is downloaded before you leave the states. For iPhones, please make sure you have downloaded the app: SNAPSEED for editing and that your phone photos are backed up with either google photos or iCloud storage.

Bring a notebook or journal and plenty of pens and pencils.
