School Improvement Plan

Board Goals: Student Learning

Starting on page 5, three out of five board goals are student data related. Using the determining factor of “masters grade level standards”. A member asked a question regarding the dip in 5th grade math mastery level scores due to the 20% decrease. In response to the drop the campus is implementing a fifth grade math teacher and the math intervention teacher will work with fifth grade teachers and students towards improving scores. All grades will participate in a STAAR Interim to aid in growth. (The STAAR Interim will also be given to all students in grades 3-5 and in all subject areas.) All STAAR testing is done on a computer-teachers are implementing practice/assessments on the computer and a technology class is in the magnet rotation.

An intervention teacher was hired hourly to pull 2nd-5th grade students to relieve a small group of students from a teacher’s schedule which will allow teachers to focus on special population groups and work to close gaps. It will allow teachers to meet the needs of lower performing students while also giving the higher academic students an opportunity, too.

A member asked about district/school provided resources and when or how it will be implemented. Items such as IXL, Imagine Math and Imagine Literacy. The member wants to know about student understanding, based on these programs, before a graded assignment actually comes home. Homework is offered to show understanding before grading occurs.

In regard to supporting goals, there is a math and reading intervention teacher present at Kolter. An additional instructional coach, Ms. Morris, was brought on this year to aid in teacher needs. PLCs will also be held with the additional instructional coach. Implementing RTI (Response to Intervention) PLCs once a month.
