# HELMS After School Program (ASP) 2012-2013 Information Page PLEASE READ CAREFULLY TO NOTE CHANGES

<u>Description of the After School Program (ASP) and Hours</u> - The program consists of one hour of language specific homework assistance followed by one hour of a variety of enrichment classes. Students will receive a daily snack during the program. The program will start the first day of school, Mon., Aug., 22, 2011. The hours are: **Mon.-Fri. 3:15-6:00.** <u>Students must be picked up by 6:00 p.m.</u> (Schedule: 3:15-3:30 snack time, 3:30-5:30 enrichment period). Classes end at 5:30. Pick up period is from 5:30-6:00.

<u>Registration</u> - Students must be registered in the After School Office by ASP staff and payment must be made <u>BEFORE</u> a student is able to stay in the program. Please **do not** drop off forms in the main office. Make sure to list current phone numbers and emergency contact information. This is for the safety of your children. <u>Please notify us immediately if your phone number changes</u>. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis. Some classes may be capped.

<u>Fees</u> - Monthly payments are calculated on a sliding scale and are based entirely on income. Therefore, we require income verification (paycheck stubs, etc.) for all adult household members to calculate the monthly payment. If you do not wish to apply for a reduced payment, the monthly flat fee is \$210.00 per month for one child, \$300 for two children, \$50.00 each additional child. (Aug. 27<sup>rd</sup>-31st - \$70 one child, \$40 additional child). Payments are due the 1<sup>st</sup> week of each month. A payment schedule is attached for your convenience. Late payments may result in loss of placement in the program. Please keep your receipts as proof of payment. We are only able to accept <u>cash or money orders</u>. Fees may vary based on program changes.

<u>Late Fees</u> – The ASP program staff is scheduled to leave at 6:00 p.m. In the event a student is not picked up by 6:00 p.m. a staff member is required to stay. Therefore, a late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be charged. Late pick-ups and non-payment of program or late fees will be cause for dismissal from the program.

<u>Rules</u> - Students are expected to adhere to the HISD Student Code of Conduct at all times. Repeated or excessive violation of rules can result in suspension or dismissal from the program. Students must remain with an ASP staff member at all times. No gum, candy, or electronic devices such as games, I-pods, etc. are allowed. If a student has a cell phone, it must remain off during program hours. As per HISD policy, **cell phones** that are on or used without permission during ASP hours will be confiscated and subject to the HISD return fee of \$15.00. If a student needs to make a phone call, they must check with a program staff member for permission. Students are expected to have their homework and necessary supplies and let the ASP instructor know what their assignments are. We will do our best to help students to complete their homework during this time, however, completion of homework is ultimately the student's responsibility.

<u>Pick Up Procedures</u> –Please enter through the main school entrance and sign students out at the ASP desk. An After-School staff member will call for the student, **or** request that you walk to the classroom to pick up your child. For security reasons, parents are not to proceed to the classroom without a pass or permission from a staff member.

### Helms After-School Clubs Descriptions

Athletics - Our feature sport for Athletics for the first semester is soccer. Soccer is the most played sport in the world and loved by our kids here



at Helms. Due to the popularity of the game we will offer the sport for students in grades 2 through 6. There will be two teams consisting of grades 2 and 3 and then a team of grades 4, 5 and 6. In the spirit of competition, teamwork, and setting and reaching goals, we will host several games with local elementary schools and have intramural play within our school. There is a strongly likelihood that we will compete in a local youth soccer league. It is our mission to use athletics to build self-esteem, self-discipline, teamwork, and leadership among the youth at Helms. The H.I.S.D. Code of Student conduct will be adhered to ensure the safety of all students. Helms soccer program is a co-ed program.

**Youth Fitness: Music and Movement** – as part of the Athletics program we desire to help kids get active and fit. Music and Movement will feature fun physical activities involving low impact exercise techniques often set to music. Through Youth Fitness we aim to teach students healthy lifestyle choices, self-responsibility, and stress management. This is the perfect class to get a sedentary student moving and energized through fun physical activities.

<u>Visual and Performing Arts</u> - The Visual and Performing Arts Club will feature the Helms News Station with weekly broadcasts totally directed and presented by the Visual and Performing Arts Club. It will feature interviews with students, teachers, the principal, and members of other clubs. The broadcast will also be posted online and brought to you by local businesses in the Heights area. **Photography and Beginners Piano** classes will also be a part of the Visual and Performing Arts Club. The life-skills we aim to teach the students through this club are how to wisely use resources, how to plan and organize, and how to communicate effectively.





<u>Band</u> — The Band Club will feature monthly performances as well as a new partnership to perform at local junior high school football games. We will continue to pursue opportunities for the club to participate at professional sporting events as well as local parades. Also included in this club are the **Mariachi Band, Drumline,** and **Rock Band.** The Band Club's staff seeks to teach the students the importance of cooperation, contributions to group effort, and accepting differences through music.

<u>Creative Writing and Publishing</u> is a class that features creative writing in the areas of poetry, short stories, prose, and essays. The students in Creative Writing and Publishing class will become published authors by the end of the semester as their work will be featured in a paperback collection presented by the class. The book will sale at the Helms campus and have shelf space in the Helms library. This class seeks to target such life-skills as sharing, critical thinking, character, and nurturing relationships.





**Martial Arts** - The well-rounded teachings of martial arts can positively impact kids by enhancing their life-skills and placing emphasis on their values and attitudes. Karate employs techniques that build strength, endurance, flexibility, posture, balance and coordination. While the physical benefits of karate are undeniable, this popular sport has many non-physical benefits on children as well.

Martial Arts enhances self-esteem, confidence, focus and self-discipline and this class will seek to provide these to our students involved in the class.

Please choose only one class from each time slot below. The student's schedule should reflect a specific club joined for their MWF activities and two Tuesday & Thursday elective activities. The elective activity can be cross club as we want all of our students to be well rounded individuals but do choose wisely as the classes are filling and the period to add/drop a class with Mr. Preston is from September 3-14. All of our after-school staff and service providers are looking forward to having a great semester with a focus on more specialized learning in each club. An emphasis has been placed on performances to allow our students to show what they have learned and to give parents, peers, and the community an opportunity to share in their success. There are 80 days in the fall semester and we are going to take advantage of each and every one of them in order to enrich the lives of Helms students. See you at 5:30.
