#### What is the TSI?







#### How is this year is different?

- 1. There is a new STAAR EOC test. Scores will not be reported in time for students to use English II and Algebra I to qualify for classes.
- 2. HCC will have to wait for TEA to determine new cutoffs if any.
- 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> grade students will have no other way to qualify for dual credit classes except for for fall 2023 courses.

#### How may changes affect students?




- Without TSI completion, 10<sup>th</sup> grade students will be ineligible to enroll in ENGL 1301/1302 and HIST 1301/1302
  - These courses are mandatory to receive the Associate's Degree.
  - These courses must be taken in order.
- Students enrolled in Geometry and Algebra II will not be able to enroll in MATH 1314 OR MATH 1316.
  - Math is a requirement for the Associate's Degree
- Students can only take five college courses per semester. (15 hours)
  - If they do not qualify by the 11<sup>th</sup> grade it becomes difficult to reach the required 60 hours to earn the Associates Degree.
