1. Safety
 - a. Nurse Hall shared concerns about parents in the cafeteria in the morning – what do we do when parents don't respond to staff members who direct them?

2. 2018-2019 HISD Budget
 - a. Mr. Greenberg shared the preliminary budget projections for the district and how that impacts the campus, difference in versions 1 and 2 that he has received from the district; there will be an updated version now that the recapture payment has been reduced from 208 million to 115 million. Discussions between a PUA and an FTE model, parents shared their impression of the community meet with Sue Deigaard, discussed essential positions. Questions about impact of cuts on custodial services.
