- 1. Safety
 - a. Review Drills- One fire drill in August. We will begin tracking adults during fire drills. Next fire drill will be September 27th.
 - b. Schedule Drills (fire, intruder, inclement weather) October 19th intruder drill, October 11th fire drill, November 9th inclement weather drill, November 27th fire drill
 - c. Concerns from parent received via email:
 - All parents must be badged to enter the building in the morning
 - Visitor log all parents must sign out- will look at adding signs to remind visitors to sign out
 - Badges will receive a sticker to show that it is current for this school year.
 - Visitors show badges in the camera and run through raptor prior to entering the building- SCMC shared that concern was understood but seemed excessive. SDMC shared that once you come in the building you are secured in the office unless you are allowed access and this is not feasible at this time.
 - Parent proposed having a full time officer- this position was \$57,000
 a year. Currently this money is not in the school or PTO budget.

Parent suggested that PTO could provide funding to possibly provide self defense classes for teachers. Dan explained the full lock down practice drills that have been done with staff and the emphasis will always be for teachers to keep children safe, not necessarily engage in an emergency situation. HISD PD does do drive by checks on campus.

- Bullet proof glass on front door- All windows would have to be replaced to make this effective.
- Update and train all staff on proto calls- These trainings and plans are reviewed with staff.

2. 2018-2019 Condit Budget

- a. Snapshot and enrollment- PUA went down this year. Several neighboring schools are well below their numbers. We are currently 10 over our projected number. Current enrollment 770.
- 3. School Improvement Plan Executive Summary & HISD Parent University- Goals and school summary were shared. Tomorrow's parent university meeting we will share school accountability ratings. Shana Halvorsen asked about special education programs on campus and adding a goal about identifying students with reading disabilities. IAT process was explained to how academic data is tracked on students. Ways to bring the IAT process and dyslexia into a schoolwide goal were discussed on how it could be incorporated.

 - Breakfast- students who arrive 7:30-7:40- take breakfast to the classroom.
 - Lunch- kids are efficient getting through the time. By law lunch can not be served before 10. Lunch is served until 12:52pm each day.
 - Voice of Concern- Form was presented so that parents can share concerns with SDMC.
 - Data for closing achievement gaps- this year we did not meet our growth goal for closing achievement gaps. Dan explained STAAR data chart.
 - Racial equity form- form was shared to think about as larger decisions are made for the school.
