

Scarborough High School Community Service Award

Community Service is important not only to the community but also to the students serving the community. The students can benefit from the exposure to new places and ideas to which they normally would not be exposed. Many scholarship applications ask students to list community services they have been involved with during their high school career.

Students who complete the number of service hours required will be recognized at graduation. Students will receive their cords during the Texas Scholar Program.

Students CANNOT get paid for this volunteer work. All hours of community service are to be worked outside of school hours. Students are to complete the community service on the weekends or after school hours. **Court-mandated community service hours CANNOT be used for this award.**

ACCEPTABLE TYPES OF COMMUNITY SERVICE

- Helping community members with household chores
- Volunteer work for organizations, such as NHS, Student Council, & ROTC
- Peer tutoring
- Volunteer work for the city or county
- Painting, picking up trash
- Boy and Girl Scout community service activities
- House cleaning for elderly residents
- Preparing meals for needy families
- Mowing grass for the elderly
- Cleaning up parks
- Blood donations: Two hours will be given for blood donations
- Hair donations: Five hours will be given to a student for a donation of hair to "Locks of Love"

REQUIRED HOURS

To receive the **Community Service Cord** students will need to complete 100 hours of Community Service. Verification of these hours will be kept in Mrs. Gabler's office. Documentation Forms are available in the Library and Front Office.
