PROGRAM DETAILS:

Club WITS is designed as a stand-alone, parent-funded program for 2nd grade and up to be held on a school campus during after-school hours.

WITS writers work with a group of 6-15 students for one hour a week during after-school hours in a variety of genres — fiction, poetry, and non-fiction — that help students develop their voices and imaginations to become published writers and storytellers.

COST:

\$245 per student for 15, hour-long visits
