I will be mindful of what I post or submit online. Ask for help when I need it. I will not store additional items in the Chromebook I will ask a teacher for guidance if I am not sure that I compartment other than the laptop itself. I will not eat or drink near technology equipment. am using technology the right way, or if the website I am using is appropriate. Avoid unsafe or dishonest internet practices. Return equipment and accessories on time. I will not share my login and password. I will return the Chromebook and all accessories I will not log into computers or programs with anything during my designated "end of year" campus collection other than my school account. dates, or pay for any unreturned items. I will not use technology to cheat or copy someone I will return the Chromebook and all accessories if I else's work. withdraw, or transfer from Lanier M.S. to another I will never share my personal information such as my school, or pay for any unreturned items. phone number or home address online or in emails.
