This week, students begin a new cycle of magnet rotations and have the opportunity to participate in each class for a full 2 weeks for the first time this school year. Our 2 week rotation helps students to engage in innovative project-based learning. In all magnet classes, our superstars will dive into a long-term assignment that requires exploration and critical thinking to complete. Please keep in mind that absences, late arrivals, and early pickups affect students in their enrichment courses as well — one missed day is 45 minutes that your child has lost in completing a project or rehearsing for a performance. That 45 minutes may mean that your student is not prepared to present a final product at the end of the week. We appreciate you making every effort for your child to be here 100% every day as we work to support student success!
