

Explanation of Magnet Application Results

Very Important! To Accept a Seat at a Magnet program:

For offers on Notification Day - March 23, and before April 3, 2016

By April 6, 2017

- **Accept the seat online or in person**
- **Provide proof of current residence, and**
- **Proof of age** (if your child will be entering Pre-K or kindergarten)
- The school will be able to provide you a copy of the **entrance agreement** that you will be required to sign.

For offers on or after April 6, 2017:

Within 3 schools days of the offer

- **Accept the seat online or in person**
- **Provide proof of current residence, and**
- **Proof of age** (if your child will be entering Pre-K or kindergarten)
- The school will be able to provide you a copy of the **entrance agreement** that you will be required to sign.

Deliver, in person, the documents listed above and sign the entrance agreement. 3. Complete the campus enrollment process. 	Deadline: April 6, 2017
Offered Seat <i>For offers on or after April 6, 2017</i>			<i>After April 6, 2017</i> Deadline: 3 school days
Waitlist	Your child has qualified and has been placed on the waitlist. The number indicates the current place on the waitlist.	If you wish to stay on the waitlist no action is required. You can contact the school for updates of your waitlist number.	August 11, 2017.
(Qualified Pending)	Because your child still needs to be tested but has otherwise met all the requirements for this Vanguard program, he or she was entered into the lottery. The school is offering a seat or has placed him/her on the waitlist for the 2017-2018 school year, <i>conditional upon receiving a high enough score for the missing test(s).</i>	For applicants with no email address, the coordinator for this school will attempt to call you to discuss your options.
