  - Top priority is to advise for Associate Degrees
  - You must email from your HCC email address
- TSI Complete
- HCC Waiver on File with HCC (submitted by HAIS during Spring of Junior Year)
- Dual Credit students only have 2 attempts to take a class
  - A "D" is passing at HCC
  - Receiving a W, F, FX all constitute an attempt
  - A W, F, FX result in a 50W on your HISD transcript and will impact your high school GPA

### **Things to Consider**

- HCC Courses taught by HAIS teacher- Ms. Devaney will/can enroll
- AP Commitment- If you enroll in an AP class in the Fall, you must complete the course (you cannot drop mid-year)
- Academic Standing at HCC
  - Are you on Probation/Suspension?
  - Do you meet the prerequisites for the class
  - Can you self enroll?
- Other required high school electives: fine arts (A/B parts), health, foreign language, PE,
- Required HAIS 12th grade electives

- Mr. Smith's Class (all seniors take it, no exceptions)

- Access using HISD login.
- <u>Choose only 1 SPECIFIC career choice and be decisive about it. It needs to be job or industry</u> <u>specific.</u>
  - If you are interested in being an anesthesiologist they should put exactly that and not the broader field of healthcare or medicine. It helps and matters when it comes time to begin working on your capstone project.
  - This is one experience and will not determine your final career choice in life.

# Senior Internship (Entrepreneurship Practicum)

Do's, Don'ts & Requirements to Remember for Internship

- DO attend your internship every Friday as mandated by the Texas Education Agency.
- DO walk your own path. It will matter when it comes time for you to begin your Capstone project.
- DO dress professionally. You will have the HAIS Senior Intern polo to wear to work on Fridays.
- DO behave professionally at your internship. Your performance can have an impact on future HAIS students being allowed to intern at the business that accepts you
- Seniors are REQUIRED to provide their own transportation to and from their internship.
- Seniors are REQUIRED to be off campus after 8 AM, and at their internship by 8:30 AM. DO NOT return to campus for any reason on Fridays.
- Seniors are REQUIRED to have an internship secured before the first HISD class day.
- DO NOT choose an internship just because your friends are choosing it.
- DO NOT get fired from your internship. Fired = an F in Career Prep
- DO NOT ask to intern at any high school including HAIS.
- DO NOT skip your internship.
