I am updating this with more information about completing the forms we need and making your choice referenced in the article below. You received a letter from your teacher with instructions on how to set up your account in the Parent Portal.

First, go to this site to access HISD Connect Parent Portal: http://hisdconnect.houstonisd.org/public/

Once you are there, follow the instructions on your letter to set up your account.

Once your account is set up, you have some things to do. If you have had children in school before, you know that you always get a big packet of forms to fill out at the beginning of school. This is YOUR homework! Starting this year, you will complete those forms electronically on your parent portal.

Here is a video to help you sign in and do your required forms and make your choice of virtual or inperson instruction:

Click on the left where it says FORMS, and a list of forms will appear in the main body of the page. You will complete ALL the forms shown. When you are ready to SUBMIT, look for the arrow to reveal a choice to SUBMIT FOR FAMILY. That way you won't have to redo the forms for every child! In some ways, this will make our lives easier!

One of the forms is called STUDENT COMMITMENT, and this is where you make your virtual or face-to-face learning choice.

Virtual vs. Face-To-Face Instruction - It's Your Choice

Here are some things you should know as you make your choice for the second 6-week grading period:

- Certified teachers will provide instruction in the classroom and virtually. These teachers may not be the teachers you currently have, and may not even be Walnut Bend teachers.
- Physical distancing will be enforced with reduced class sizes.
- Physical distancing signage will be placed around the campus.
- Facilities, Maintenance, and Operations will distribute personal protective equipment (PPE) to each campus on a weekly and monthly basis.
- PPE will include thermometers based on the number of students.
- Each week, schools will receive disposable masks (one per staff member and one per student), and wipes will be provided for classrooms and campuses.
- Each month, gloves will be provided for classrooms and campuses.
- A health screening app will be used by employees for check-in.
- Masks are always required to be worn properly by students and staff.
- Students will need to take laptops/Chromebooks home in the event they need to switch to virtual instruction.

Also, to ensure that we continue to support our families, our Communications Department created a video that provides a glimpse of how schools would look like when face-to-face instruction resumes. Please watch the video so you have a better idea of what it will look like.
